KEY ACTORS

OBJECTIVE

Country packages for forests, climate, and nature were first developed under the FCLP in 2023 as a groundbreaking new approach to support countries in achieving their ambitious forest and climate goals. They bring together governments, the private sector, philanthropy and multilateral institutions to help fill critical gaps in implementation.

DEFINING THE PROBLEM

Country packages will support tropical forest countries to achieve their goals related to reducing deforestation supporting the GLD goal.

VALUE ADD

Country packages are focused on filling critical gaps of implementation, especially those related to financial needs, to achieve reducing deforestation in tropical forest countries. Crucially, each country package is led by the tropical forest country itself, in accordance with its national priorities.

COP30 DELIVERABLES

1. Countries with country packages already launched present progress made by initial investments.
2. Colombia announces initial partners and support for country packages.
3. Peru launches its country package.
4. Potential launch of process to establish Country Packages in additional countries.

FCLP SYNERGIES

Country packages are one of the initiatives to support countries under Pillar 3 “National Climate and Forests Action”. Additionally, each host country can further align its design and implementation of their country packages with policy action elements that are part of Pillar 2.

PROGRESS TO DATE

1. Five country packages launched (DRC, Ghana, PNG, ROC and Gabon).
2. FCLP has provided a working-level platform for information exchange between hosts, donors and partners through regular International Working Group meetings and Package Advisory Group launched and with meetings convened.



3. FCLP Secretariat has engaged with and provided information to interested countries (e.g. Peru, Pakistan, Lao, Kenya, Korea, Nigeria, Cambodia).
4. Development of resource material to support host countries and interested partners in designing and implementing country packages.
5. Contracting of limited in-country support (Colombia, DRC, Ghana, Peru).
